



**NOTES:**

1. In approximately level terrain, a **DANGER TREE** is any tree or part of any tree which is within the **WIRE ZONE** or would reach within 10 feet of a transmission conductor in falling, per the Transmission Vegetation Management Plan (TVMP) section 3.1.
2. Inspectors will identify all **DANGER TREES** which shall be removed, pruned or topped within the ROW and oversee the mitigation of such trees. Danger trees in the **BORDER ZONE** (outside of the easement/ROW), Inspectors shall make every effort to contact the property owner to obtain written documentation granting permission for the removal, pruning or topping of the danger tree(s). The Inspectors shall supervise the mitigation of such trees per the Transmission Vegetation Management Plan (TVMP) section 2.2.2a and section 2.2.2b.
3. As directed by the inspectors, trees within the rights of way (ROW) shall be cut so that stumps will not prevent the passage of vehicles and equipment along the ROW.
